2. ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to registered members aged 18 years or over of clubs affiliated to the ACU, SACU, or the MCUI riding one of the following classes of four-stroke machine, manufactured on or before the 31st December 1964.

(1) Under 300cc solo machines

(2) Over 300cc machines - no rear suspension

(3) Over 300cc machines - with rear suspension

(4) Open Class - any eligible machine of any capacity. A more challenging route See Guide notes

(5) Solo Girder Fork machines

(6 Solo Clubman Class - any rider on any eligible solo machine. Non award winning basis. See Guide notes

(7) Any rider 65 years or over on any solo machine of any capacity

(8) Machines with or without rear suspension and sidecar manufactured on or before 31st December 1969

3. ENTRIES: Will be limited to those 240 riders with entry form fully and correctly completed in BLOCK CAPITALS. All correct entries received by the closing date of January 15th will be allocated by ballot. Preference will be given to 2022 class winners. Unsuccessful entrants will have their entries returned within 14 days of the closing date. Online ACU entry or Postal entries to the Secretary of the Meeting.

4. FEE: £35.00 per entrant. Non-UK riders must have a Start Permission and valid competition licence from their home FMN and must arrange their own medical/repatriation insurance. See quide notes. Cheques and postal orders made payable to TALMAG MCC. 5. COURSE: Will be at Hungry Hill, Aldershot, Hampshire.

6. AWARDS: Best performance in each Class (except Class 6) - Tankard. Runner-up – suitable plaque. Subject to 6 entries in each Class.

7. SCRUTINEERING: All machines will be scrutinised. See guide notes.

8. AFFILIATION. All competitors MUST be either A.C.U. affiliated or have a Start Permission from their home FMN. See guide notes.

9. MEDICATION: A competitor may be asked to take part in a drugs test. When signing on it is the competitor's responsibility to declare any drugs they may be taking.

10. If a non-starter, it is required that you explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the Rules.
